

If your GARBAGE DISPOSAL is not working, try these steps:

- If your garbage disposal does NOT have power:
 - Garbage disposals are usually operated by a lightswitch near the kitchen sink. Ensure you are flipping the correct lightswitch.
 - Check the breaker to see if it has been tripped (flipped).
 - IF it has, try flipping it back and see if it will stay.
 - The garbage disposal could be connected to a GFCI outlet please refer to If an electrical outlet doesn't have power.
 - The GFCI outlet being tripped could prevent the garbage disposal from working.
- If your garbage disposal DOES have power (sometimes you will hear a faint humming sound):
 - o Press the reset button on the bottom of the disposal.
 - With the garbage disposal turned off, clean out any obstructions that might have accidentally fallen into the garbage disposal.
 - Take an allen wrench (should be located under your kitchen sink) and insert and twist the wrench in the bottom center of the garbage disposal.
 - This spins the blades of the disposal manually.
 - Please watch this video for a visual.
